## **Public School Dress Code**

### AN ACT

Amends the Public School Code to increase dress code standards.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

#### Section 1. Dress code

- (1) Public schools shall enforce the following standards:
  - a. Boys' and Girls' standards:
    - i. Earrings, accessories, or any form of headwear are not to be worn

       including but limited to baseball hats, headbands, durags, knit
       hats, beanies, or visors.
      - 1. Except girls may have only two earrings in each ear.
    - ii. Body piercings, ear gauges, or visible tattoos of any kind are prohibited. Any student with a tattoo or who gets a tattoo must cover it completely.
    - iii. Only closed toe and heeled shoes are permitted.
    - iv. Clothing must be neat and clean.
    - v. Writing and/or images on clothing may not be vulgar, or on an inappropriate location when worn.
  - b. Boys' standards:
    - i. Hair must be neat, well-groomed, trimmed around the ears, and out of the eyes. Braids, cornrows and dreadlocks are permitted.

Extreme or exotic hairstyles are not permitted. Students must be clean shaven.

- c. Girls' standards:
  - i. Hair must be a natural hair color, though it does not have to be the student's natural color.
  - ii. Simple jewelry and reasonable make up may be worn.

## Section 2. Exemptions

(1) The board of director's for a school shall review all religious, medical, and other related exceptions.

This act shall take effect at the beginning of the 2027-2028 school year.
