Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Tax

AN ACT

An act establishing a one cent tax per ounce on sugar-sweetened beverages.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Tax - A one cent per ounce tax, in addition to all other applicable sales tax, is implemented on all sugar-sweetened beverages sold in the Commonwealth. Sugar-sweetened beverages include:

- (1) Regular soft drinks/soda
- (2) Diet soft drinks/soda
- (3) Fruit beverages
- (4) Sport drinks
- (5) Ready-to-drink tea
- (6) Ready-to-drink diet tea
- (7) Energy drinks
- (8) Ready to drink coffee

Section 2. Exclusion – Flavored water drinks are excluded from the Sugar-Sweetened Beverage Tax.

This act shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

Fiscal Impact: a one cent per ounce tax on all sugar-sweetened beverages generates approximately \$730 million in revenue for the Commonwealth.
